Program Overview

This program provides opportunities for students to develop their self as much as possible by giving exposure to the community. There are 6 stages of programs: 1) collecting epidemiologycal data, 2) cause-effect analysis to create empowerment programs, 3) advocacy to stake holder to support the program, 4) implementation of integrated program involving stake holders and community concerned, 5) program evaluation to get a feedback, and, 6) planning new innovative programs based on program evaluation.

Field of Study

Dental health care management, epidemiology, biostatistic, research method, control and prevention of oral and dental diseases, planning and evaluation for oral health, and social and behavioural sciences as applied to dentistry.

Goals

- 1. Creating student long-life learning on community empowerment in real community setting.
- 2. Obtaining epidemiological data from the community to design innovative empowerment programs and publications.
- 3. Empowering stake holders with an integrated approach.

Program Schedule

The program will run two times each calendar year. First session from June to August, and Second Session from December to February. The exact date is negotiable.

Length of Program

It is 6-weeks full-time program, equivalent to 48 hours or 3 credits.

Status of Preceptors

Undergraduate students majoring in Dentistry or Dental Hygienist from Universitas Airlangga and Foreign University.

Subspecialty Areas Offered for Preceptorship

- 1. Observing and analyzing primary and secondary findings (health data), both independently and jointly with stakeholders
- 2. Data processing to become a logical, systematic and verification description so that an epidemiology-based program can be produced.
- 3. Designing, conduct, learn advocacy and negotiate, and evaluate community empowerment programs, both individually and in groups, organized in collaboration with relevant stakeholders.

This program will be supervised by Lecturer of Dental Public Health Department and Public Health Center dentists.

Application Procedure

Applicants must submit all of the following materials (translated in English):

- Curriculum vitae and education transcripts
- 2. Motivation letter to joining the program
- 3. A confidential reports (Recomendation Letter)
- 4. The Immunization documentation, which includes:
 - a. Name, month, day, and year of vaccination
 - b. Signature and name of licensed provider

Admissions Process

The admissions committee considers the following criteria in its decisions:

- 1. Academic achievement (GPA and class rank if available)
- 2. Motivation letter
- 3. Content of confidential reports

Application Deadline

First Session postmarked by April 1st, Second Session postmarked by October 1st

Tuition Payment

Six Week Program tuition is 500 USD

Accomodations and Transportation

Preceptors may stay at the selected hotel prepared by Host. The expenses is 50 USD/1 person/day. The preceptors will get standard 3 star hotel facilities. Daily meal is excluded.

Regulation

Immigration: All preceptors who plan to attend the Preceptorship Program should contact Indonesia Embassy in your country, and make sure that you are required to obtain an entry visa or not departing on your Length of Preceptorship Program **Health Insurance**: All preceptors who plan to attend the Preceptorshop Program are required to be insured under an adequate medical insurance plan during all periods of Preceptorship Program. Medical insurance is not provided by the Faculty of Dental Medicine, Universitas Airlangga.

Medical Clearance: All preceptors are required to obtain a medical clearance prior to enrollment in the Preceptorship Program for individual and community health reasons.
